



Philippine Geothermal Production Company, Inc. (Philippine Geothermal) is a Filipino corporation operating the Tiwi steam fields in the province of Albay and the Mak-Ban steam fields in the provinces of Batangas and Laguna. It is owned by Allfirst Equity Holdings, Inc. (60 percent), an affiliate of SM Investments Corporation, and Chevron Geothermal Philippines Holdings, LLC (40 percent).

Tiwi and Mak-Ban are the result of a successful partnership between Philippine Geothermal's predecessor and the National Power Corporation that began in 1971, when a 2.5 kW government experiment was transformed into the first commercial geothermal power project in Southeast Asia, and led to the birth of the geothermal industry in the Philippines. The Tiwi and Mak-Ban geothermal fields supply steam to third-party-owned power plants with a total installed capacity of 692 MW.
